Camp security for me and in my name whatsoever the same
shall amount to and upon the Receipt thereof acquittances
of other discharges by him to be given in my name by virtue
hereof In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this 6th Day of Jan. Anno Domini 1787
