Sir

With your Honour's Letter of the 27th last
Month; I received a line from General M^r Clair
informing me that the Clothing and Prisoners
here are to be sent to Philadelphia
and as there were regular Troops at this Place,
the Officer who had the Charge of the Prisoners
thought it unnecessary to take a guard of the
Militia.

I have hired a Waggoner to go with
the Officer and guard, who is to find his own
Provisions & Storage; and to have seven pounds
and ten shillings specie for his reward
The owner of the Waggon, M^r William Alexander
will deliver this. Therefore requests Council
to pay him the sum above mentioned
