Sir

With your Honours Letter of the 27th last
Month; I received a line from General M^r Clair
informing me that the Clothing and Prisoners
here are to be sent to Philad^a - - -
and as there were regular Troops at this Place,
the Officer who had the Charge of the Prisoners
thought it unnecessary to take a guard of the
Militia.

I have hired a Waggoner, to go with
the Officer and guard, who is to find his own
Provisions & Storage; and to have seven pounds
and ten shillings specie for this reward -
The owner of the Waggon Mr William Alexander
will deliver this. Therefore requests Council
to pay him the sum above mentioned -
