- A. Two Cook Houses, each 30 Feet Square, 20 feet high to the Square.
 - B. Two Kitchens for two Sergeants and Guards.
 - C. House for the Major Guard - 50 feet by 20.
 - D. Thirty-two Barracks of Ten Rooms each 15 by 18 feet clear of the Logs, the whole length of each Barrack, 228 Feet.
 - E. Four Barracks of Ten Rooms each 15 by 18 feet clear of the Logs, the whole length of each Barrack 190 Feet.
 - F. Two Houses for Captains and Subalterns, four Rooms each 15 by 18 feet the whole length of each Barrack 80 Feet.
 - G. The Major, and Lieut. Colonels Houses.
 - H. The Colonels House.
 - I. Two Store Houses, 200 feet by 18 clear of the Logs.
 - K. Necessary Houses
- a a a. Necessary Houses within the Picket to be but eight: one in the front, and one in the Rear of each Column of Houses.
